Offered by online learning, supported by staff from the Centre for Rural Childhood, the Certificate blends the theoretical background of Restorative Practice and Justice with its practical implementation in a variety of contemporary settings.

The Programme structure consists of 4, 15 credit modules, delivered within the UHI two semester cycle, commencing subject to validation in January 2011; 2 modules being completed by candidates each semester, as below:

15 credit **Origins of Restorative Justice.** First Semester

15 credit **Implementing restorative policies in practice.** Second Semester

15 credit **International perspectives in restorative practice.** Second Semester
